Palin Parent Child Interaction Therapy (Palin PCI) is an evidence-based early intervention programme for children who stammer.

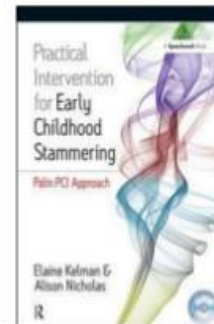
This one-day introduction will cover the theoretical framework which underpins the programme as well as an outline of the assessment process from which each individual child's therapy programme is devised. The three streams of interaction, family and child strategies will be described with video illustrations. The evidence base for this approach will be summarised.
